

OSAKA CASTLE



Osaka Castle was originally built in 1583 by the order of Hideyoshi Toyotomi, however the castle suffered several destructions throughout its history. The current Osaka Castle was built in 1931 with the external appearance of the castle built by Hideyoshi Toyotomi. In 1997 the Japanese Government designated the main tower as a Registered Tangible Cultural Property. Osaka Castle also features an observation deck at the top floor and a museum inside where you can find a large variety of historical materials and displays. Osaka Castle is illuminated after dark making an outstanding sight which can be seen from a great distance
